Bad Cholesterol Is Catching Up with Maharashtra

Mumbai, Dinesh Singh :

A quiet but dangerous shift is unfolding across Maharashtra as elevated levels of LDL cholesterol, also known as "bad" cholesterol, are placing millions at risk of premature heart attacks and strokes. New data reveals that more than one in four adults in the state now struggle with high cholesterol, with LDL being the most critical contributor. Maharashtra has emerged among the top five states in India for LDL prevalence, with a particularly sharp rise in the 35 to 54 age group. This is a concerning shift, as cardiovascular disease was once considered a later-life condition. Now, Indians are experiencing cardiac events at younger ages than ever before. Nearly 50 percent of heart attacks in India occur before the age of 50, and 25 percent strike before 40. The median age for a first heart attack in India is now around 53, almost five years younger than in the West. The surge in LDL levels is not confined to urban centers. Rural parts of Maharashtra are showing similar trends due to lifestyle



transitions—less physical activity, increased consumption of processed and fatty foods, and higher stress. The prevalence is nearly equal among men and women, and silent progression of LDL damage means many remain unaware until a sudden cardiac event changes their lives forever. Across Western India, over three-fourths of the population now shows at least one lipid abnormality. Nationally, 81 percent of Indians have abnormal cholesterol profiles

driven largely by high LDL, low HDL, and raised triglycerides. These abnormalities are now among the top contributors to cardiovascular deaths, which already account for more than a quarter of all deaths in the country each year. Despite clinical guidelines recommending routine cholesterol checks and aggressive LDL control for high-risk individuals, screening and treatment rates remain low. New therapies are available, including

advanced treatments such as PCSK9 inhibitors and Inclisiran for patients who do not respond to statins, but access remains uneven and awareness poor. "LDL cholesterol is often called 'bad cholesterol' for a reason. Its rise is silent but deadly, leading to sudden cardiac events that could have been prevented. Maharashtra needs a targeted and urgent response starting with regular testing, early lifestyle intervention, and, when necessary, escalation to newer treatments. While statins remain the gold standard, newer therapies like Inclisiran are emerging globally as a valuable tool for patients who fail to reach

LDL targets or are intolerant to existing treatments. Their twice-a-year dosing also makes long-term adherence more feasible for select high-risk individuals," said Dr. Sharukh A. Golwala, M.D. (Medicine), D.M. (Cardiology), Consultant Cardiologist at Breach Candy, Reliance, Parsi General, and Jaslok Hospitals, Mumbai. The expert agrees that this is not just a medical issue—it is a public health emergency. The costs of inaction will be severe, from rising mortality to increasing pressure on hospitals and long-term declines in workforce productivity. The time to act is now, before bad cholesterol catches Maharashtra off guard.
